

GTC Completes Work on Boulder's Special Transit Center

New Transit Center is a Model for Green Building

olden Triangle Construction (GTC) recently com-

Deleted construction of Boulder County's new Special Transit facility on 63rd Street in Boulder, Colorado. This new 37,323 square foot building will contain administration and



maintenance facilities for the non-profit agency that provides transportation services to seniors and people with disabilities residing in Boulder County.

The new building, designed by OZ Architecture, will more than double the size of Special Transit's previous facilities.



The Boulder Special Transit project was completed in January 2011.

The building encompasses two terraces, the higher of which contains administration services, classroom and break areas, a scheduling and dispatch center, and staff Th offices, areas

The lower

terrace houses vehicle maintenance and parking facilities for up to 100 buses. This area also includes six bays with vehicle lifts and fluid-dispensing systems for bus maintenance, a drive-through wash bay and a fueling station. The new Special Transit is a model of "green" building technology, as it will incorporate such features as a solar panel array, low VOC interior finishes and energy efficient exterior glass providing natural light. The building will also include water-reducing plumbing fixtures, extensive use of recycled materials, a ra-

diant floor slab in the garage/maintenance area, and selfdimming and occupancy sensing lighting.
