GTC is pleased to announce the recent groundbreaking of two new projects. Denver Public Schools is renovating and doing a 12,500 sf addition to its **McGlone Academy** campus in Northeast Denver. The addition will be comprised of nine classrooms, with renovations to the science labs, bathrooms, playground, and playfields. McGlone Academy will remain occupied throughout construction. The project is designed by [DLH Architecture](#). Meanwhile, up in Westminster, **Woodrow Wilson Academy**, which services K-8, is receiving a two-story, 13,800 sf addition for its middle school program. The addition, designed by [Hollis and Miller](#), includes a new commons area, cafeteria, warming kitchen, supporting middle school classrooms, and small entry vestibule.
